Mo	15	Apr	Completed yards lay up and underway for sea trials in Hawaiian waters.
Tu	12	Nov	Departed Pearl Harbor for Far East WESTPAC tour.
Fr	22	Nov	Arrived in port at Yokosuka, Japan.
		Dec	Operating in the Sea of Japan. Sonar contact with a Soviet Class WHISKEY submarine, hull number 050. The submarine was attempting covert operations within the carrier task group (USS HORNET) in which we were operating. Alternated sonar attack prosecution with the USS CARPENTER DD-825. The next morning the submarine surfaced to charge batteries after the arrival of a Soviet Frigate, hull number 056 and a low fly over by a Soviet BADGER aircraft. We passed within 100 yards of the surfaced Soviet submarine.
